

PERSONALIZED LABELS: CONSTRUCTION NOTES

In this exercise you create personalized labels. You will need the following supplies to complete your stitch out:

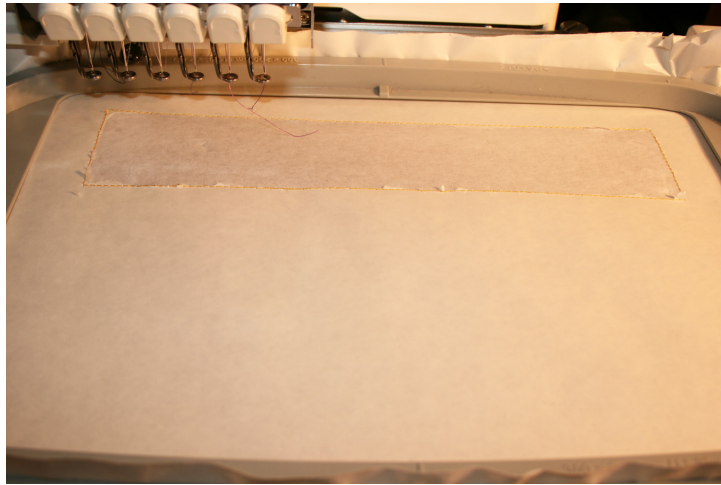
- 3 11” pieces of washable satin ribbon
- Floriani Perfect Stick
- Floriani Heat N Sta
- Floriani DreamWeave (optional)
- Steam-A-Seam 2
- Hobby or Mini Iron

DIRECTIONS FOR LABELS

1. Cut a piece of Floriani Perfect Stick and hoop it paper side up in the 200x300 hoop.
2. Cut pieces of Floriani DreamWeave and fuse to the back of the ribbon pieces to help keep the satin from running.
3. Stitch out the first placement rectangle. If you are using a multi-thread machine, use the Reserve Stop button to allow you to place the ribbon after the rectangle has stitched out.



4. Remove the paper backing within the first placement rectangle.



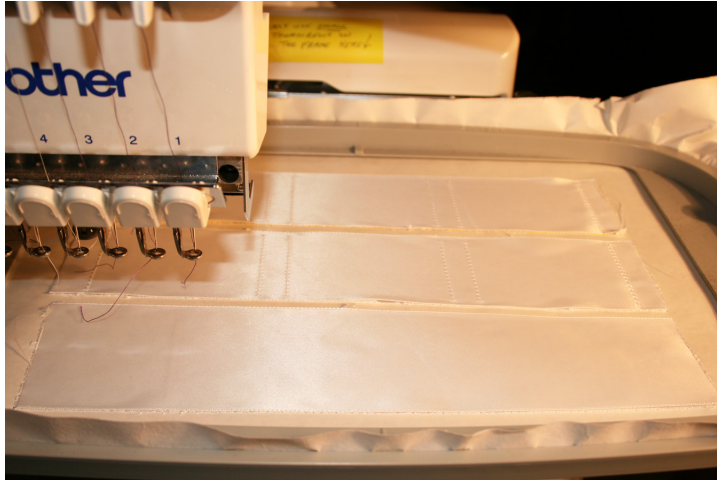
5. Place the precut 11” ribbon inside the placement rectangle.
6. Start the embroidery machine again. The tack down lines for the first ribbon stitch out.



7. The second placement rectangle stitches out. If you are using a multi-thread machine, use the Reserve Stop button to allow you to place the ribbon after the rectangle has stitched out.
8. Remove the paper backing within the second placement rectangle.
9. Place the second precut ribbon piece.
10. Start the embroidery machine again. The tack down lines for the second ribbon stitch out.
11. The last placement rectangle stitches out. If you are using a multi-thread machine, use the Reserve Stop button to allow you to place the ribbon after the rectangle has stitched out.

12. Remove the paper backing within the third placement rectangle.

13. Place the last precut ribbon.



14. Restart the machine and let the rest of the labels stitch out.



15. When the labels have finished stitching remove the hoop from the machine and trim the jump stitches.
16. Remove the ribbons from the Perfect Stick.
17. Fold the ribbon so that the right tack down stitch from the first label aligns with the left tack down line from the second label.
18. Cut between the ribbons on the fold. This will give you a 1/4 inch overlap past the tack down line.
19. Fold the label so that you can use the 1/4 inch overlap as a template for trimming the other end of the label.



20. Trim the other labels similarly.

DIRECTIONS FOR AFFIXING THE LABEL TO YOUR PROJECT

1. Cut two pieces of Steam-A-Seam 2 to the height of your label.
2. Cut a piece of Floriani Heat N Sta for the woven project to which you want to affix your label.
3. Fuse the Heat N Sata to the back of your project.
4. Hoop the fused project.
5. Stitch out the placement lines for the label and remove the hoop from the machine.



6. Align the long edge of the first piece of Steam-A-Seam 2 against the inside of the first tack down line on the back side of the label.
7. Fold the left side of the label at the tack down stitch to the back of the label over the Steam-A-Seam.
8. Fold the right side of the exposed Steam-A-Seam back over the folded in ribbon edge.
9. Align the long edge of the second piece of Steam-A-Seam against the inside of the second tack down line on the back side of the label.



10. Fold the right side of the label at the tack down stitch to the back of the label over the Steam-A-Seam.



11. Fold the left side of the exposed Steam-A-Seam back over the folded in ribbon edge.



12. Place the label with the folded in edges within the placement lines on the hooped project.

13. Press gently with the mini iron to affix the label edges to the project.



14. With the label affixed to your project, return the hoop to your embroidery machine.out.



15. Finish your stitch out.
